

*DESCRIPTION*

The land embraced in the annexed plan of STRAWBERRY POINT BLUFFS, a subdivision of part of the southeast and greater portion of section 25, and part of the southwest one quarter of section 25, in North Range 5 East, Livingston County, Michigan, is described as follows: Commencing at a point in the north and south grain line of section 25; running northwardly along the south boundary line of section 25, thence 1.187 feet northwardly to the right in the arc of a circle, a distance of 100 feet, thence 1.187 feet northwardly along the south boundary line of section 25, to a point in the north and south grain line of section 25; thence 1.187 feet westwardly along the south boundary line of section 25, to the point of commencement.


