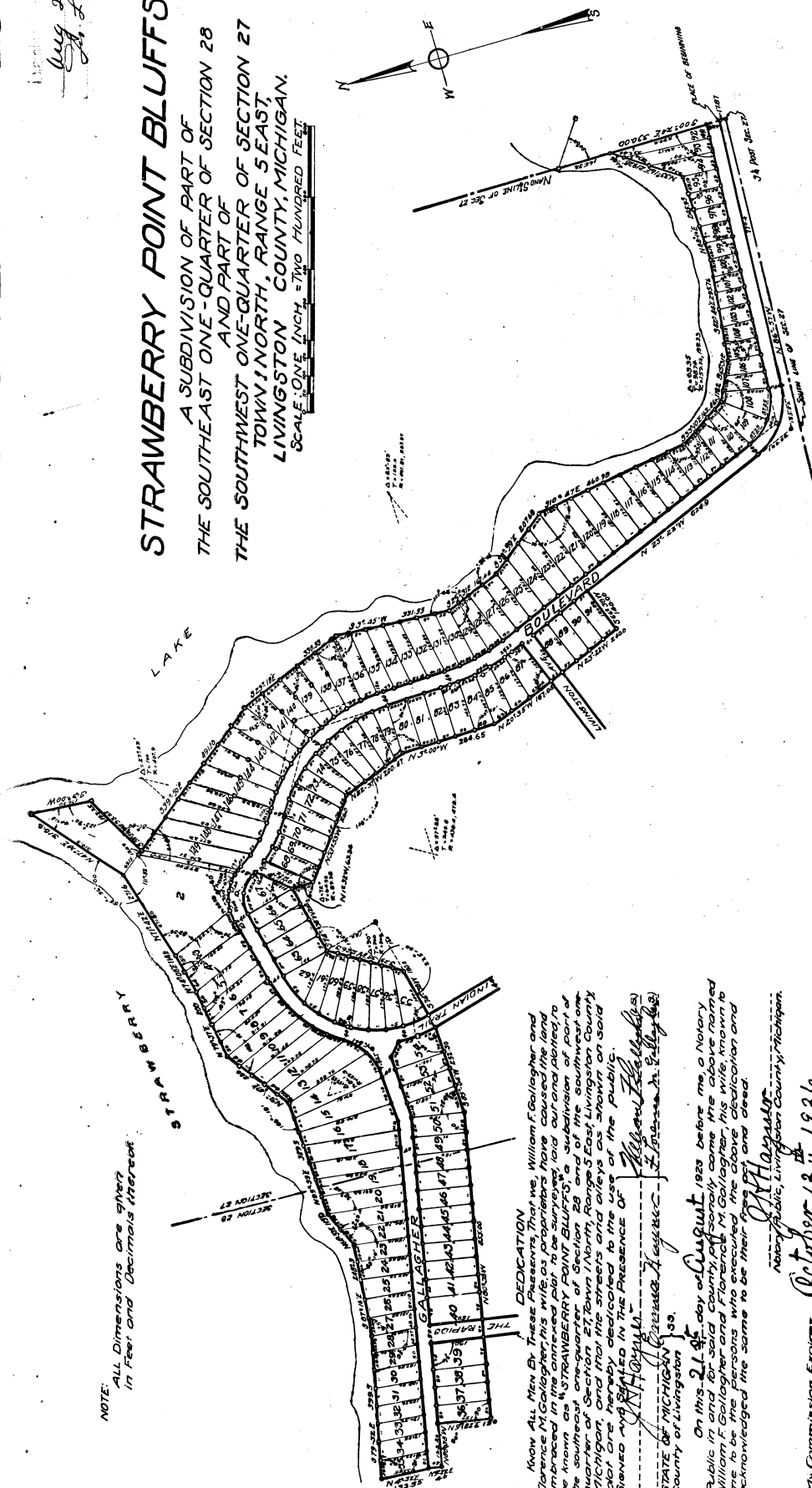


A SUBDIVISION OF PART OF

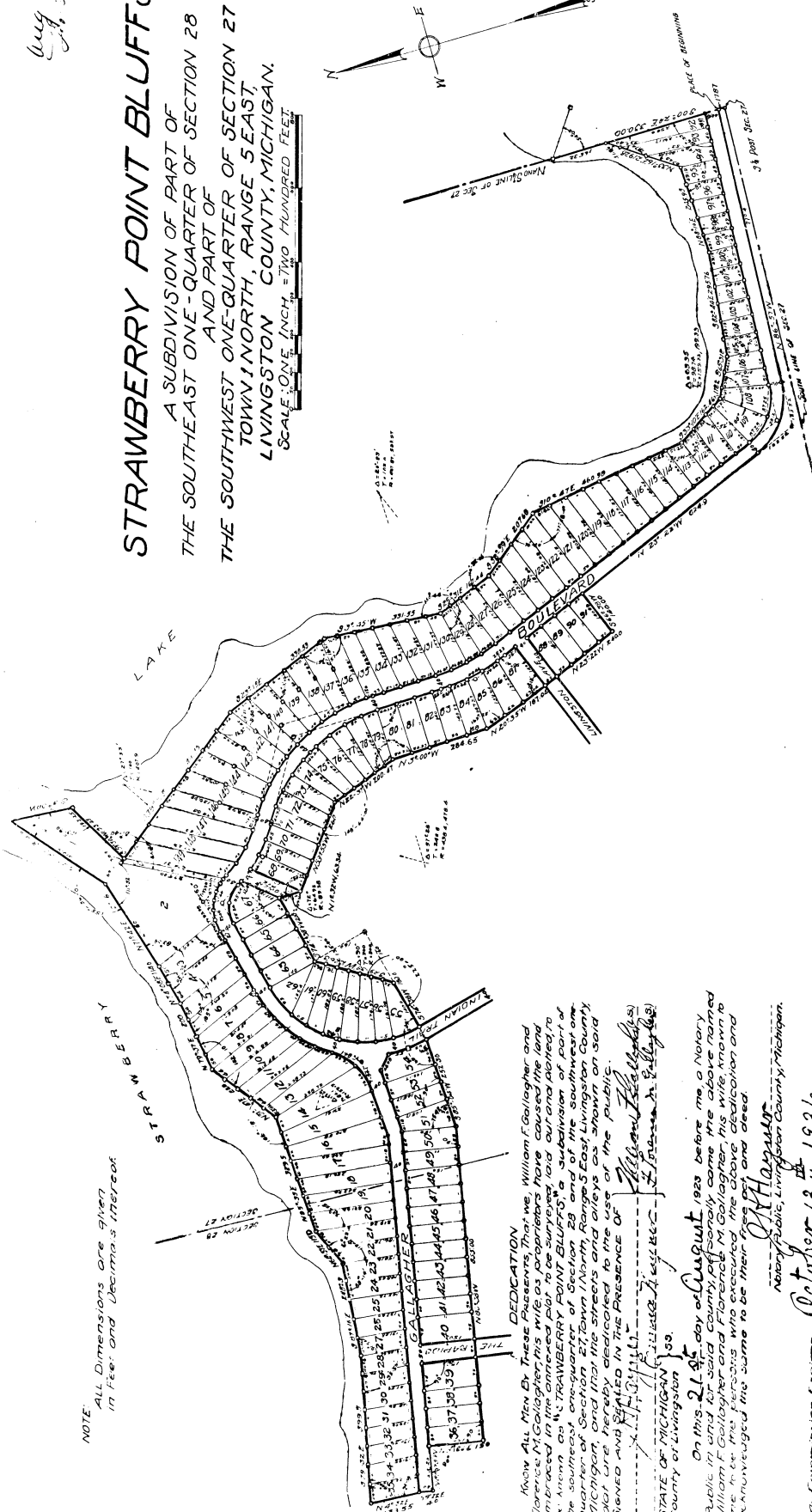
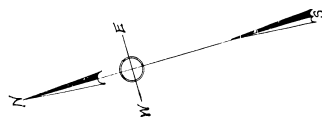
